Scandinavian Films

Siri and Max Fenson and I have provided a few recommendations for Scandinavian films that we can stream on our computers and televisions. Below is a short list with brief descriptions. You are sure to find a few that you will want to watch.

Happy, Happy is a 2010 Norwegian comedy about two couples whose relationships become entangled around sex and love and happiness. Kaja is a schoolteacher who lives in the snowy countryside with her glowering husband, Eirik. Their lives are jolted by the arrival of new next-door neighbors. Rated R. Apple TV, Prime Video.

Troubled Water is a 2008 Norwegian film. Released from prison after serving an eight-year sentence for the murder of a young child, Thomas returns to Oslo to pursue a quiet redemption. He finds work as a church organist and develops a rewarding relationship with a priest and her young son. The film is about people who try to come to terms with the past and explores the possibilities for forgiveness. Headhunters is a 2011 Norwegian action thriller film based on the novel by Jo Nesbø. Roger Brown is an insecure corporate recruiter who lives a double life as an art thief to fund his lavish lifestyle. Apple TV, Paramount.

Narvik is a 2022 Norwegian film about the people and events that surrounded the 1940 Battle of Narvik, which was the largest battle fought on Norwegian soil and regarded as Hitler's first loss. It is an intriguing World War II story involving a small Norwegian town at the center of an iron ore struggle between Germany and Great Britain. Netflix.

Becoming Astrid is a coming of age story of the Swedish author, Astrid Lindgren, the author of Pippi Longstocking. The film depicts her from age 16 to her early 20s. It is a gorgeous piece of heritage filmmaking. Apple TV, Prime Video

Good Evening, Mr. Wallenberg is a 1993 Swedish film about the last days of World War II in Budapest. It is a film about the Swedish World War II diplomat Raoul Wallenberg, who was instrumental in saving the lives of thousands of Hungarian Jews from the Holocaust. Apple TV, Prime Video.
